

CLARIFICATION NOTICE: [®]Teva-Fentanyl Patch Identifier Poster

Dear valued Teva customer,

We have recently received feedback about some problems pharmacies have been having in identifying returned [®]Teva-Fentanyl patches using the [®]Teva-Fentanyl Patch Identifier poster.

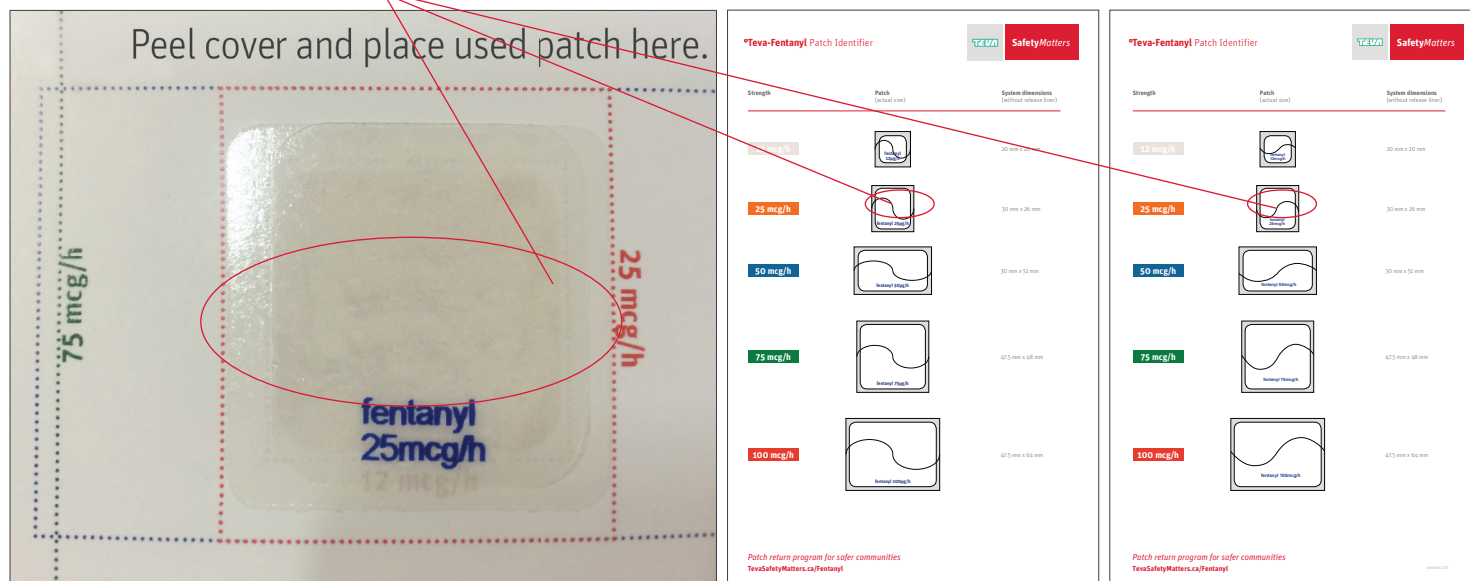
The images on the poster are sized to match exactly the patches that patients will return, as well as indicating the correct prescription/dosage markings.

However, the images on the **poster depict unused patches**. When patients return used patches, you will not see the wavy line marking as indicated on the [®]Teva-Fentanyl Patch Identifier poster. This marking is part of the release liner that is discarded when a patient uses the patch.

To confirm the authenticity of returned patches, please only compare them against patch size and prescription marking on the [®]Teva-Fentanyl Patch Identifier poster.

Below are images of an **opened, returned patch** and an unused patch (as indicated on the [®]Teva-Fentanyl Patch Identifier poster).

Please note the absence of the wavy line marking; the size and all other aspects remain the same.
