

## Welcome to the Octreotide Patient Care Program<sup>SM</sup>

### Important Information You Should Know

You have been prescribed <sup>Pr</sup>Octreotide for Injectable Suspension, and we are pleased to inform you that you are eligible to take advantage of the benefits in the Octreotide Patient Care Program<sup>SM</sup>.

After you are enrolled in this program, a case manager will help you navigate insurance and provide you with details on the financial assistance that is available for <sup>Pr</sup>Octreotide for Injectable Suspension.

Your case manager will also coordinate a date, time and location for you to have your injection administered. Injections will be scheduled in a clinic and administered by a nurse.

*<sup>Pr</sup>Octreotide for Injectable Suspension therapy must be administered by a trained healthcare professional only.*

### How do I enrol in the program?

Either your physician or pharmacist will complete the enrolment form and submit it to the Octreotide Patient Care Program<sup>SM</sup>. You also have the option of enrolling yourself by calling **1.877.445.6984 (Monday to Friday, 8 am - 8 pm EST)**. They will require your name, date of birth, address, phone, email and private insurance coverage information.

Within one business day of receiving your enrolment form, a case manager from the Octreotide Patient Care Program<sup>SM</sup> will reach out to you to conduct a welcome call to:

- Confirm information already provided by your healthcare professional
- Discuss insurance information and reimbursement navigation
- Confirm your pharmacy of choice to receive the medication and review details for the safe handling of the medication
- Confirm date, time and location for you to have your injection administered once coverage has been secured

### What is available to me?

In some cases, the Octreotide Patient Care Program<sup>SM</sup> can provide you with personalized financial solutions to help you get started with your treatment.

A case manager will help determine the insurance coverage and reimbursement options for your <sup>Pr</sup>Octreotide for Injectable Suspension, prescription. They will:

- Ask for any outstanding information about private insurance/coverage information
- Contact insurance company(s) to collect coverage details
- Review coverage details with you
- Assess co-pay assistance
- Discuss out-of-pocket expenses and any concerns you may have
